Professional interviews from the candidate's perspective

Applying for Chartered membership

- Working in waste services team of local authority for 7 years
- Graduate member for four years
- Once I decided it was time to apply
 - Attended interview workshop in March 2016
 - Sat interview in June 2016

Benefits of Chartered membership

- Shows commitment to the industry and professionalism
- Shows a commitment to your own CPD
- Attending regional centre events
- Being part of the New Member Network
- Sharing best practice with other members in the region

Preparing for the interview

- Three aspects to prepare for:
 - Presentation and questions
 - Wider waste knowledge questions
 - CIWM and career related questions

- Know the marking criteria
- Know the interviewers

Preparing for the presentation

- How I chose my topic
 - I could demonstrate my involvement and contribution
 - Felt it showcased the skills required
 - Industry Knowledge
 - Technical competence
 - Management skills
 - Ability to Organise
 - Independence
 - I was able to highlight successes and challenges for discussion
 - I was comfortable explaining why I did things a certain way

The presentation

- I took hard copy of the slides for each interviewer
- Practiced timings beforehand, so I knew I could complete it in the 10 minutes
- Didn't just read the slides engaged with the interviewers throughout
- Ready for questions

Preparing for the wider waste knowledge questions

- You must show that you have "acquired an understanding of the industry beyond your own area of expertise."
- I prepared by:
 - Reading the last 6 months of CIWM journals, and making notes on any articles covering key 'hot topics'
 - Familiarised myself with the potential question topics on the CIWM website and made sure I filled in any gaps
 - Regularly read News Online and Letsrecycle
 - Attended the interview workshop
 - Attended regional CIWM meetings and NMN national event
 - Discussions with another member of my team going for chartered membership

Wider knowledge questions

- Felt like a structured conversation rather than an interview
- Answers led to other questions
- Wider waste topics covered
 - 'Brexit'
 - Waste policy and strategy in the UK
 - Circular economy
 - Landfill and Energy from waste
 - Environmental permitting
- CIWM and career specific questions
 - Why do you want to be a chartered waste manager?
 - How have you been involved in CIWM?
 - How do you see your career developing?

My advice...

- If you meet the criteria, and are able to demonstrate your skills and experience then go for it.
- Use the information available on the CIWM website
- Prepare well
- Show your enthusiasm
- Don't be afraid to give opinions
