



CIWM Cymru Wales Centre Site Visit

At the Cardiff County Council MRF in Lamby Way

A new Materials Reclamation Facility has opened in Lamby Way in June 2006. The multi-million pound plant is one of the only publicly owned plants of its kind in the UK in operation and is able to process recyclable waste 10 times faster than before. It has four sorting cabins, compared to one previously and uses state-of-the-art equipment for separation, with workers deployed around the plant to remove any contaminated materials. Under current operations it has been estimated that the new plant is able to process 60,000 tonnes of recyclable waste per year – enough to fill a quarter of the Millennium Stadium.

Directions:

From the A48 (from Newport – East)

From Eastern Avenue (A48), branch left (signposted Dock, Cardiff East), then at roundabout take the 1st exit onto Southern Way - A4161 (signposted Docks, Cardiff East).

Keep to the right-hand lane to cross the flyover onto the A4232 (signposted Docks).

At the roundabout take the 1st exit onto Lamby Way.

At the next roundabout, take the 3rd exit into Lamby Way Depot. The visitor car park is straight on.

From the A48 (from the West)

From Eastern Avenue (A48), branch left (signposted Dock, Cardiff East), then at the roundabout take the 3rd exit onto A4161 (signposted Docks, Cardiff Bay).

Keep to the right-hand lane to cross the flyover onto the A4232 (signposted Docks).

At the roundabout take the 1st exit onto Lamby Way.

At the next roundabout, take the 3rd exit into Lamby Way Depot. The visitor car park is straight on.
