National Permitting Service Vision Statement

- **The National Permitting Service will regulate emissions to the Environment by:**
 - **Determining applications under the regulatory regimes for which it has delegated authority in a manner that protects the Environment.**
 - **Produce regulatory documents that are compliant with the law.**
 - **Produce regulatory documents that can be clearly understood by all who use them.**
 - **Maintaining an appropriate balance between cost, time and quality so as to afford the right level of environmental protection in a timescale that meets the reasonable expectation of our customers.**

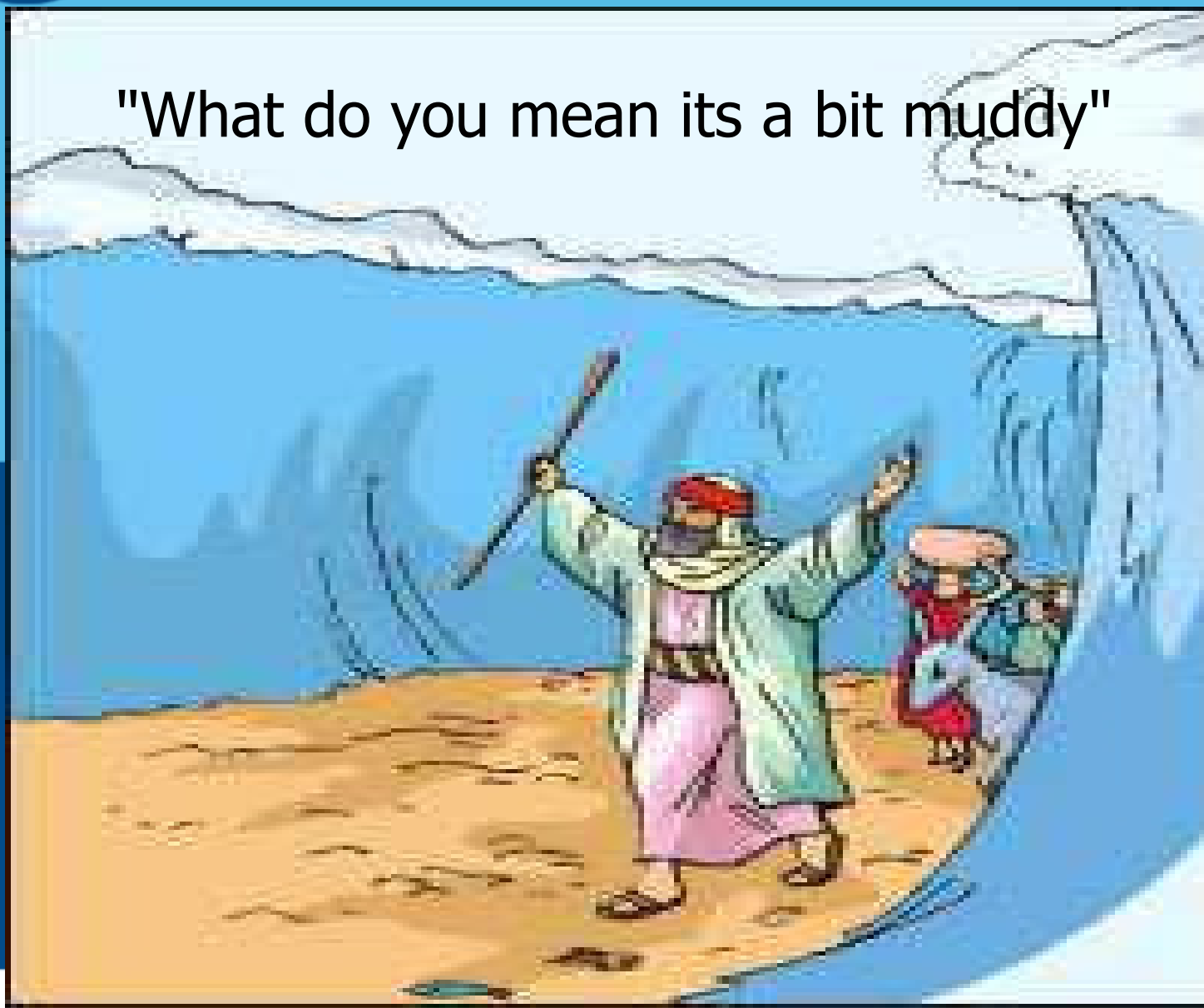


National Permitting Service Vision Statement
