# Sheffield office directions

## By rail

Sheffield Station is close to the Nabarro offices, and is on the main line from London St Pancras.

To take a taxi to the office, follow the signs in the station for taxis. To walk to the office, follow the signs within the station for supertram, on exiting the station turn left and follow the path alongside the tram line for approx. 1,000 yards, follow the signs around and across the tram line. At this stage a large 'wheel' shaped bridge should be visible to your left, do not cross this bridge. Instead take the path which runs down to its right and take the footbridge. The office is now visible to your right from this footbridge, follow the path to the office entrance which is located to the rear or to the front of the building.

## By car

From the M1. Leave the M1 at junction 33. Follow the signs for the A630 (Sheffield) which becomes the A57 Sheffield Parkway. Almost at the bottom of the Parkway, on the approach to the Park Square roundabout, the road splits into four lanes with two sets of traffic lights. The first two lanes lead into the city centre and the other two lanes lead to South Quay and Victoria Quays. Stay in the third lane. After the next set of traffic lights, turn immediately left into South Quay and follow the road to Nabarro's car park.

**Note:** if you miss the turning, you will pass the Victoria Quays public car park situated on your left. At the next set of traffic lights turn left into Furnival Road and left again at the next set of traffic lights on to Exchange Street.

## From Exchange Street

Turn left onto Wharf Street, Victoria Quays and follow the road round to the right to the car park barrier.

## Visitor parking

Please press the green button at the car park barrier to contact security for access. Visitor parking is opposite the front entrance to the building.
