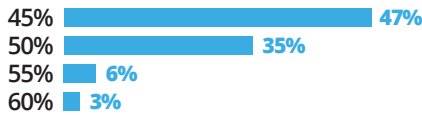
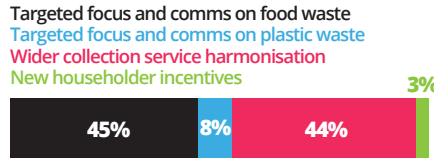

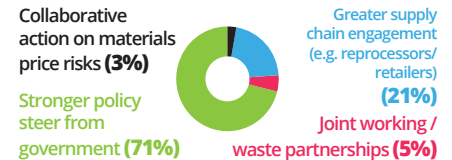
1 With the current policy framework, which of the following is a realistic recycling rate target by 2020?

5 Should the Government undertake a complete review of Extended Producer Responsibility opportunities post-Brexit?



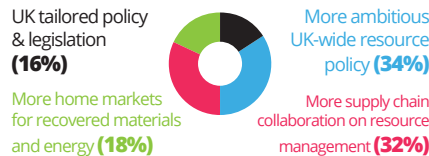

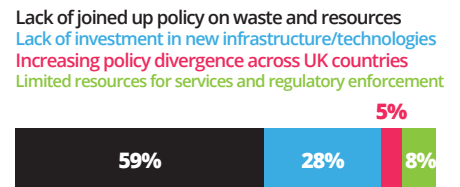

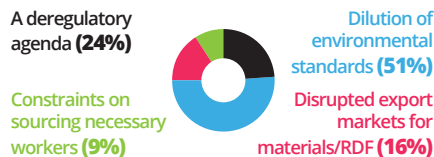
